1. The property seized was one (1) Ruger LCP .380 semi-automatic handgun, Serial #373-82074.

2. The property was seized at approximately 6:15 p.m. on March 23, 2017 at 408 South Queen Street, Lancaster, Pennsylvania.

3. The registered owner of the property is Deborah Fay McClucas.

4. The person in possession of the property at the time of seizure was Jovana Lawrence.

5. The property is subject to forfeiture pursuant to Section 5802 of the Judicial Code, 42 Pa.C.S.A. 5802, based upon the following averment of material facts:


On or about March 23, 2017, at approximately 6:15 p.m., members of the Lancaster County Drug Enforcement Task Force executed a Search Warrant at 408 South Queen Street, Lancaster, Pennsylvania, the residence of Michael Julius Jordan and Jovana Lawrence.

In the kitchen, on top of the refrigerator, Detectives located a Ruger LCP .380 semi-automatic handgun with a Ruger magazine loaded with four (4) bullets. In a cabinet above the refrigerator, Detectives located a digital gram scale.

In the dining room, Detectives located a U.S. Postal box from California addressed to 408 South Queen Street, Lancaster, Pennsylvania. IT SHOULD BE NOTED THAT it is common for individuals in the business of selling marijuana to get packages from California.


